Adoption of ORDINANCE 1215

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE  
REGULATION OF POULTRY IN GENERAL RURAL ZONING DISTRICT

The Board of Supervisors for the Town of Big Lake, Sherburne County, Minnesota, hereby ordains that on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 2020, the Big Lake Township Board of Supervisors adopted the above Ordinance, a brief summary follows:

- Section 1.**           **Purpose.** Identifies the purpose of the Ordinance
- Section 2.**           **Scope.** Identifies the scope of the Ordinance.
- Section 3.**           **Compliance.** Defines compliance of the Ordinance.
- Section 4.**           **Definitions.** Clarifies language used in the Ordinance.
- Section 5.**           **Enforcement.** Identifies who will enforce the Ordinance.
- Section 6.**           **Right of Entry.** Defines the ability of entry to property.
- Section 7.**           **Records.** Defines how records will be maintained.
- Section 8.**           **Regulations.** Defines the size of township properties on which poultry may be kept, the number of animals permitted on those properties, structures needed for the animals, and sanitation measures needed to be met.
- Section 9.**   **Date of Effect.** Identifies the effective date of the Ordinance.

Ordinance 1215, an "Ordinance Regulating Poultry in General Rural Zoning District" shall take effect and be in full force immediately following its adoption and upon publication. A copy of the Ordinance can be viewed during regular Township office hours. An additional copy of the Ordinance will also be on file at the Sherburne County Law Library, located at 13880 Business Center Drive, Elk River, Minnesota.
